

**NOTICE OF BOND SALE**

**Bids.** Written or facsimile bids for the purchase of the above-referenced bonds (the “Bonds”), of the City of Colwich, Kansas (the “Issuer”) herein described will be received on behalf of the undersigned Clerk of the Issuer at the address hereinafter set forth, until 11:00 a.m., Central Daylight Time (the “Submittal Hour”), on

**APRIL 18, 2011**

(the “Sale Date”). All bids will be publicly evaluated at said time and place and the award of the Bonds to the successful bidder (the “Successful Bidder”) will be acted upon by the governing body at its meeting to be held at 7:00 p.m. on the Sale Date. No oral or auction bids will be considered. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the hereinafter referenced Preliminary Official Statement relating to the Bonds.

**Terms of the Bonds.** The Bonds will consist of fully registered bonds in the denomination of \$5,000 or any integral multiple thereof (the “Authorized Denomination”). The Bonds will be dated the date of issuance and delivery (the “Issue Date” or “Dated Date”), and will become due in principal installments semiannually on April 1 and October 1 in the years as follows:

The Bonds will bear interest from the Dated Date at rates to be determined when the Bonds are sold as hereinafter provided, which interest will be payable semiannually on April 1 and October 1 in each year, beginning on October 1, 2011 (the "Interest Payment Dates").

**Place of Payment.** The principal of and interest on the Bonds will be payable in lawful money of the United States of America by check or draft of the Treasurer of the State of Kansas, Topeka, Kansas (the "Paying Agent" and "Bond Registrar"). The principal of each Bond will be payable at maturity or earlier redemption to the owners thereof whose names are on the registration books (the "Bond Register") of the Bond Registrar (the "Registered Owner") upon presentation and surrender at the principal office of the Paying Agent. Interest on each Bond will be payable to the Registered Owner of such Bond as of the fifteenth day (whether or not a business day) of the calendar month next preceding each Interest Payment Date (the "Record Date"): (a) mailed by the Paying Agent to the address of such Registered Owner as shown on the Bond Register or at such other address as is furnished to the Paying Agent in writing by such Registered Owner; or (b) in the case of an interest payment to Cede & Co. or any Owner of \$500,000 or more in aggregate principal amount of Bonds, by wire transfer to such Registered Owner upon written notice given to the Paying Agent by such Registered Owner, not less than 15 days prior to the Record Date for such interest, containing the wire transfer address to which such Registered Owner wishes to have such wire directed.

**Bond Registration.** The Bonds will be registered pursuant to a plan of registration approved by the Issuer and the Attorney General of the State of Kansas. The Issuer will pay for the fees of the Bond Registrar for registration and transfer of the Bonds and will also pay for printing a reasonable supply of registered bond blanks. Any additional costs or fees that might be incurred in the secondary market, other than fees of the Bond Registrar, will be the responsibility of the Owners.

**Book-Entry-Only System** The Bonds will initially be issued exclusively in "book entry" form and shall be initially registered in the name of Cede & Co., as the nominee of DTC and no beneficial owner will receive certificates representing their interests in the Bonds. During the term of the Bonds, so long as the book-entry-only system is continued, the Issuer will make payments of principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the Bonds to DTC or its nominee as the Registered Owner of the Bonds, DTC will make book-entry-only transfers among its participants and receive and transmit payment of principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the Bonds to its participants who shall be responsible for transmitting payments to beneficial owners of the Bonds in accordance with agreements between such participants and the beneficial owners. The Issuer will not be responsible for maintaining, supervising or reviewing the records maintained by DTC, its participants or persons acting through such participants. In the event that: (a) DTC determines not to continue to act as securities depository for the Bonds, or (b) the Issuer determines that continuation of the book-entry-only form of evidence and transfer of ownership of the Bonds would adversely affect the interests of the beneficial owners of the Bonds, the Issuer will discontinue the book-entry-only form of registration with DTC. If the Issuer fails to identify another qualified securities depository to replace DTC, the Issuer will cause to be authenticated and delivered to the beneficial owners replacement Bonds in the form of fully registered certificates. Reference is made to the Official Statement for further information regarding the book-entry-only system of registration of the Bonds and DTC.

#### **Redemption of Bonds Prior to Maturity.**

**General.** Whenever the Issuer is to select Bonds for the purpose of redemption, it will, in the case of Bonds in denominations greater than the minimum Authorized Denomination, if less than all of the Bonds then outstanding are to be called for redemption, treat each minimum Authorized

Denomination of face value of each such fully registered Bond as though it were a separate Bond in the minimum Authorized Denomination.

**Optional Redemption.** At the option of the Issuer, Bonds maturing on October 1, 2016 and thereafter, will be subject to redemption and payment prior to maturity on April 1, 2016 and thereafter, as a whole or in part (selection of maturities and the amount of Bonds of each maturity to be redeemed to be determined by the Issuer in such equitable manner as it may determine) at any time, at the redemption price of 100% (expressed as a percentage of the principal amount), plus accrued interest to the date of redemption.

**Mandatory Redemption.** A bidder may elect to have all or a portion of the Bonds scheduled to mature in consecutive years issued as term bonds (the "Term Bonds") scheduled to mature in the latest of said consecutive years and subject to mandatory redemption requirements consistent with the schedule of serial maturities set forth above, subject to the following conditions: (a) not less than all Bonds of the same serial maturity shall be converted to Term Bonds with mandatory redemption requirements; and (b) a bidder shall make such an election by completing the applicable paragraph on the Official Bid Form.

**Notice and Effect of Call for Redemption.** Unless waived by any owner of Bonds to be redeemed, if the Issuer shall call any Bonds for redemption and payment prior to the maturity thereof, the Issuer shall give written notice of its intention to call and pay said Bonds to the Bond Registrar and the Successful Bidder. In addition, the Issuer shall cause the Bond Registrar to give written notice of redemption to the registered owners of said Bonds. Each of said written notices shall be deposited in United States first class mail not less than 30 days prior to the date fixed for redemption. All notices of redemption shall state the date of redemption, the redemption price, the Bonds to be redeemed, the place of surrender of Bonds so called for redemption and a statement of the effect of the redemption. The Issuer shall also give such additional notice as may be required by Kansas law or regulation of the Securities and Exchange Commission in effect as of the date of such notice. If any Bond be called for redemption and payment as aforesaid, all interest on such Bond shall cease from and after the date for which such call is made, provided funds are available for its payment at the price hereinbefore specified.

**Authority, Purpose and Security.** The Bonds are being issued pursuant to K.S.A. 65-163d *et seq.*, as amended, and an ordinance and resolution adopted by the governing body of the Issuer (collectively, the "Bond Resolution") for the purpose of paying the cost of certain water supply improvements (the "Improvements"). The Bonds shall be general obligations of the Issuer payable as to both principal and interest from ad valorem taxes which may be levied without limitation as to rate or amount upon all the taxable tangible property, real and personal, within the territorial limits of the Issuer. The full faith, credit and resources of the Issuer are irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of the principal and interest on the Bonds as the same become due.

**Submission of Bids.** All bids must be made on forms which may be procured from the Clerk or the Financial Advisor. No additions or alterations in such forms shall be made and any erasures may cause rejection of any bid. Written bids must be submitted in writing in sealed envelopes, by mail or hand delivered or by facsimile, addressed to the undersigned, and marked "Proposal for General Obligation Bonds, Series A, 2011." Written bids submitted by facsimile should not be preceded by a cover sheet and should be sent only once to **(316) 796-0913**. Confirmation of receipt of facsimile bids may be made by contacting the undersigned at the number listed below. Bids must be received prior to the Submittal Hour on the Sale Date accompanied by the Deposit (as hereinafter defined), which may be submitted separately, provided such Deposit is received by the Issuer or the Financial Advisor prior to the Submittal

Hour on the Sale Date. The Issuer shall not be responsible for failure of transmission of facsimile or delivery by mail or in person of any bid.

**Conditions of Bids.** Proposals will be received on the Bonds bearing such rate or rates of interest as may be specified by the bidders, subject to the following conditions: (a) the same rate shall apply to all Bonds of the same maturity year; (b) no interest rate may exceed a rate equal to the daily yield for the 10-year Treasury Bond published by *THE BOND BUYER*, in New York, New York, on the Monday next preceding the day on which the Bonds are sold, plus 6%; and (c) no supplemental interest payments will be considered. No bid shall be for less than **99%** of the principal amount of the Bonds and accrued interest thereon to the date of delivery will be considered. Each bid shall specify the total interest cost (expressed in dollars) during the term of the Bonds on the basis of such bid, the discount, if any, the premium, if any, offered by the bidder, the net interest cost (expressed in dollars) on the basis of such bid and the average annual net interest rate (expressed as a percentage) on the basis of such bid. Each bidder shall certify to the Issuer the correctness of the information contained on the Official Bid Form; the Issuer will be entitled to rely on such certification. Each bidder agrees that, if it is awarded the Bonds, it will provide the certification as to initial offering prices described under the caption "Certification as to Offering Price" in this Notice.

**Good Faith Deposit.** Each bid shall be accompanied by a good faith deposit (the Deposit") in the amount of \$47,700 payable to the order of the Issuer to secure the Issuer from any loss resulting from the failure of the bidder to comply with the terms of its bid. The Deposit, *which must be received by the Issuer or the Financial Advisor prior to the Submittal Hour*, may be submitted in any of the following forms:

- (a) certified or cashier's check drawn on a bank located in the United States of America;
- (b) financial surety bond as hereinafter described (the "Surety Bond"); or
- (c) wire transfer in Federal Reserve funds, immediately available for use by the Issuer (wire transfer information may be obtained from the Issuer or the Financial Advisor at the addresses set forth below).

Contemporaneously with the submission of a wire transfer Deposit, such bidder shall send an email to the Issuer at the email address set forth below, including the following information: (a) notification that a wire transfer has been made; (b) the amount of the wire transfer; and (c) return wire transfer instructions in the event such bid is unsuccessful. All Surety Bonds must be from an insurance or surety company rated "AA" by Standard and Poor's Ratings Services, a division of The McGraw Hill Companies, Inc., or "Aa" by Moody's Investors Service and licensed to issue such a surety bond in the State of Kansas. The Surety Bond must identify each bidder whose deposit is guaranteed by such Surety Bond. Good Faith checks submitted by unsuccessful bidders will be returned; wire transfer Deposits submitted by unsuccessful bidders will not be accepted or shall be returned in the same manner received on the next business day following the Sale Date. The Issuer reserves the right to withhold reasonable charges for any fees or expenses incurred in returning a wire transfer Deposit. If the sale of the Bonds is awarded to a bidder utilizing a Surety Bond, the Successful Bidder is required to submit to the Issuer a cashier's or certified check or wire transfer of immediately available federal funds to such financial institution requested by the Issuer, not later than 2:00 p.m., Central CDT Time on the next business day following the Sale Date. If such funds are not received by such time, the Surety Bond may be drawn on by the Issuer to satisfy the Deposit requirement. No interest on the Deposit will be paid by the Issuer. If a bid is accepted, the Deposit, or the proceeds thereof, will be held by the Issuer until the Successful Bidder has

complied with all of the terms and conditions of this Notice at which time the amount of said Deposit shall be returned to the Successful Bidder or deducted from the purchase price at the option of the Issuer. If a bid is accepted but the Issuer fails to deliver the Bonds to the Successful Bidder in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Notice, said Deposit, or the proceeds thereof, will be returned to the Successful Bidder. If a bid is accepted but the bidder defaults in the performance of any of the terms and conditions of this Notice, the proceeds of such Deposit will be retained by the Issuer as and for liquidated damages.

**Basis of Award.** Subject to the timely receipt of the Deposit set forth above, the award of the Bonds will be made on the basis of the lowest net interest cost (expressed in dollars), which will be determined by subtracting the amount of the premium bid, if any, from or adding the amount of the discount bid, if any, to the total interest cost to the Issuer. The Issuer or its Financial Advisor will compute the net interest cost based on such bids. If there is any discrepancy between the net interest cost specified and the interest rates specified, the specified net interest cost shall govern and the interest rates specified in the bid shall be adjusted accordingly. If two or more proper bids providing for identical amounts for the lowest net interest cost are received, the governing body of the Issuer will determine which bid, if any, will be accepted, and its determination is final.

The Issuer reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids and to waive any irregularities in a submitted bid. Any bid received after the Submittal Hour on the Sale Date will be returned to the bidder. Any disputes arising hereunder shall be governed by the laws of Kansas, and any party submitting a bid agrees to be subject to jurisdiction and venue of the federal and state courts within Kansas with regard to such dispute. The award of the Bonds is predicated upon the Issuer achieving a certain level of savings in conjunction with the refinancing of a certain Loan from the Kansas Department of Health and Environment to the Issuer to provide initial financing for the Improvements, such amount to be solely determined by the Issuer.

The Issuer's acceptance of the Successful Bidder's proposal for the purchase of the Bonds in accordance with this Notice of Bond Sale shall constitute a bond purchase agreement between the Issuer and the Successful Bidder for purposes of the laws of Kansas.

**Optional Bond Insurance.** The Issuer has **not** applied for any policy of municipal bond insurance with respect to the Bonds. If the Bonds qualify for municipal bond insurance, and any bidder desires to purchase such policy, such indication and the name of the desired insurer must be set forth on the bidder's Official Bid Form. The Issuer specifically reserves the right to reject any bid specifying municipal bond insurance, even though such bid may result in the lowest net interest cost to the Issuer. All costs associated with the issuance of such policy and associated ratings and expenses (other than any independent rating requested by the Issuer) shall be paid by the Successful Bidder. Failure of the municipal bond insurer to issue the policy after the award of the Bonds shall not constitute cause for failure or refusal by the Successful Bidder to accept delivery of the Bonds.

**CUSIP Numbers.** CUSIP identification numbers will be assigned and printed on the Bonds, but neither the failure to print such number on any Bond nor any error with respect thereto shall constitute cause for failure or refusal by the purchaser thereof to accept delivery of and pay for the Bonds in accordance with the terms of this Notice. All expenses in relation to the assignment and printing of CUSIP numbers on the Bonds will be paid by the Issuer.

**Delivery and Payment.** The Issuer will pay for printing the Bonds and will deliver the Bonds properly prepared, executed and registered without cost on or about **APRIL 28, 2011** (the "Closing

Date”), to DTC for the account of the Successful Bidder. The Successful Bidder will be furnished with a certified transcript of the proceedings evidencing the authorization and issuance of the Bonds and the usual closing documents, including a certificate that there is no litigation pending or threatened at the time of delivery of the Bonds affecting their validity and a certificate regarding the completeness and accuracy of the Official Statement. Payment for the Bonds shall be made in federal reserve funds, immediately available for use by the Issuer. The Issuer will deliver one Bond of each maturity registered in the nominee name of DTC.

**Reoffering Prices.** To provide the Issuer with information necessary for compliance with Section 148 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), the Successful Bidder will be required to complete, execute and deliver to the Issuer prior to the delivery of the Bonds, a written certification (the “Issue Price Certificate”) containing the following: (a) the initial offering price and interest rate for each maturity of the Bonds; (b) that all of the Bonds were offered to the public in a bona fide public offering at the initial offering prices on the Sale Date; and (c) on the Sale Date the Successful Bidder reasonably expected that at least 10% of each maturity of the Bonds would be sold to the “public” at prices not higher than the initial offering prices. For purposes of the preceding sentence “public” means persons other than bond houses, brokers, or similar persons or organizations acting in the capacity of underwriters or wholesalers. However, such Issue Price Certificate may indicate that the Successful Bidder has purchased the Bonds for its own account in a capacity other than as an underwriter or wholesaler, and currently has no intent to reoffer the Bonds for sale the public.

***Subsequent to the Submittal Hour, such initial offering prices to the public shall be provided to the Issuer or the Financial Advisor not more than 20 minutes after requested by the Issuer or the Financial Advisor.***

At the request of the Issuer, the Successful Bidder will provide information explaining the factual basis for the Purchaser’s Issue Price Certificate. This agreement by the Purchaser to provide such information will continue to apply after the Closing Time if: (a) the Issuer requests the information in connection with an audit or inquiry by the Internal Revenue Service (the “IRS”) or the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”) or (b) the information is required to be retained by the Issuer pursuant to future regulation or similar guidance from the IRS, the SEC or other federal or state regulatory authority.

**Preliminary Official Statement and Official Statement.** The Issuer has prepared a Preliminary Official Statement dated March 21, 2011, “deemed final” by the Issuer except for the omission of certain information as provided in Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 15c2-12, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk or from the Financial Advisor. Upon the sale of the Bonds, the Issuer will adopt the final Official Statement and will furnish the Successful Bidder, without cost, within seven business days of the acceptance of the Successful Bidder's proposal, with a sufficient number of copies thereof, which may be in electronic format, in order for the Successful Bidder to comply with the requirements of Rule 15c2-12(b)(3) and (4) of the Securities and Exchange Commission and Rule G-32 of the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (collectively, the “Rules”). Additional copies may be ordered by the Successful Bidder at its expense. The Issuer's acceptance of the Successful Bidder's proposal for the purchase of the Bonds in accordance with this Notice of Bond Sale shall constitute a contract between the Issuer and the Successful Bidder for purposes of the Rules.

**Continuing Disclosure.** The Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”) has promulgated amendments to its Rule 15c2-12 (the “Rule”) requiring continuous secondary market disclosure for certain issues. In the Bond Resolution, the Issuer has covenanted to provide annually certain financial information and operating data and other information necessary to comply with the Rule, and to transmit

the same to the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board. This covenant is for the benefit of and is enforceable by any Registered Owner of the Bonds. For further information, reference is made to the caption "CONTINUING DISCLOSURE" in the Preliminary Official Statement.

**Assessed Valuation and Indebtedness.** The total assessed valuation of the taxable tangible property within the Issuer for the year 2010, is as follows:

The total general obligation indebtedness of the Issuer as of the date of delivery of the Bonds, including the Bonds being sold and temporary notes of the Issuer to be sold on the same date, is \$4,580,000.

**Legal Opinion.** The Bonds will be sold subject to the approving legal opinion of GILMORE & BELL, P.C., WICHITA, KANSAS, Bond Counsel, which opinion will be furnished and paid for by the Issuer, will be printed on the Bonds, if the Bonds are printed, and will be delivered to the Successful Bidder when the Bonds are delivered. Said opinion will also include the opinion of Bond Counsel relating to the exclusion of the interest on the Bonds from gross income for federal income tax purposes and from computation of Kansas adjusted gross income. Reference is made to the Preliminary Official Statement for further discussion of federal and Kansas income tax matters relating to the interest on the Bonds.
